

XL BULLY PRACTICE POLICY

NB: AMERICAN BULL DOGS AND AMERICAN BULLY'S ARE ALL IN THE SAME CATEGORY.

We are well aware that many of these dogs are not nasty or dangerous BUT As a practice we must protect our staff, you as our clients, your pets and children-- from risk of being attacked.

THE FOLLOWING RULES ARE TO APPLIED

NEUTERING

We ask that your pet is muzzled prior to coming into our Main Clinic and wait with your pet until they are admitted and premed—sedative- administered to ensure they aren't distressed and are relaxed. We will not transport XL Bullies

EUTHENASIA: Only at Main Centre

We ask that your pet is muzzled prior to coming to our Main Clinic – sedation will be used and administered before you leave if you do not wish to stay for the duration. We will not euthanize X L Bully's at home.

STRAYS

We will NOT accept any XL Bully type strays in any of our clinics. The finder must contact the dog warden directly and they will deal with the stray unless the dog is seriously injured/ill or collapsed.

Completion of Proof of Euthanasia/ Neutering confirmation forms.

As per the Government Guidelines forms must initially be completed by yourselves with your personal details prior to presenting then we will complete the remaining part, this will be collectable from our Main Clinic once completed. There is a fee for this service

IDENTIFICATION

The powers that be are currently saying that; ' if your dog looks like an XL Bully then that is how it will be classified.'
